

OLRCB Membership Meeting
Roseburg, OR April 8, 2017 State Convention

Call to Order: The 2017 OLRCB Membership Meeting was called to order at 7:27 p.m. by President Bob Birman. It was established that we have a quorum.

President Report: President Birman welcomed everyone. This is his first time before the membership and BOD as President. He wants to become familiar with the membership and help build the club.

Minutes: Reading of the minutes was dispensed with. A motion was made to approve the December Minutes as printed in the Newsletter. MSC

Secretary Report: Secretary Rossner reported that the membership remains about the same. We have 169 total members. That number is broken down into 89 Adult members, 32 Adult Partnerships, 63 Youth, and 1 Youth Partnership.

Elections will be coming up in October. The offices of Vice President, Secretary, and three Directors will be up for election. Petitions for Office are available through the Secretary and also on the OLRCB Website. Rossner also announced that she isn't running for the office of Secretary again.

Web Report: Webmaster Blehm is working on a total update of the site. We aren't putting out a Directory this year, so she would like member contact info on a member only site. Also show catalog update messages. She is looking into implementing on-line payment which could include sanctions, membership, etc. Please feel free to contact Blehm with questions and suggestions.

Newsletter: Mailing the Newsletter is the clubs largest expense. A discussion about mailing verses emailing followed. A motion was made to have the Newsletter available on line and emailing to members. MSC

New Business: Next year's Convention will be held at Lane County Fairgrounds in Eugene. The date is April 14-15 with set-up on Friday the 13th. Birman has booked the venue for 2018 and 2019. Birman feels that Eugene is more centrally located with many motels and restaurants. The facility doesn't allow for our potluck. Therefore, arrangements are being made for a banquet facility.
